



Scoring Guide

Scoring takes place by the referee after all balls have been played by both sides, including penalty balls.

The side with the ball closest to the jack will score one point and one for each additional ball closer to the jack than the opponent's closest ball.

If two or more balls are equidistant from the jack and no other balls are closer, each ball receives one point.

Points are accumulated across all ends, with the side with the highest at the end of the game determined the winner.

If the scores are equal, a tie break is played.

The referee may call captains or players forward if measuring or discussion is to take place.
